Fluency in English and/or French language

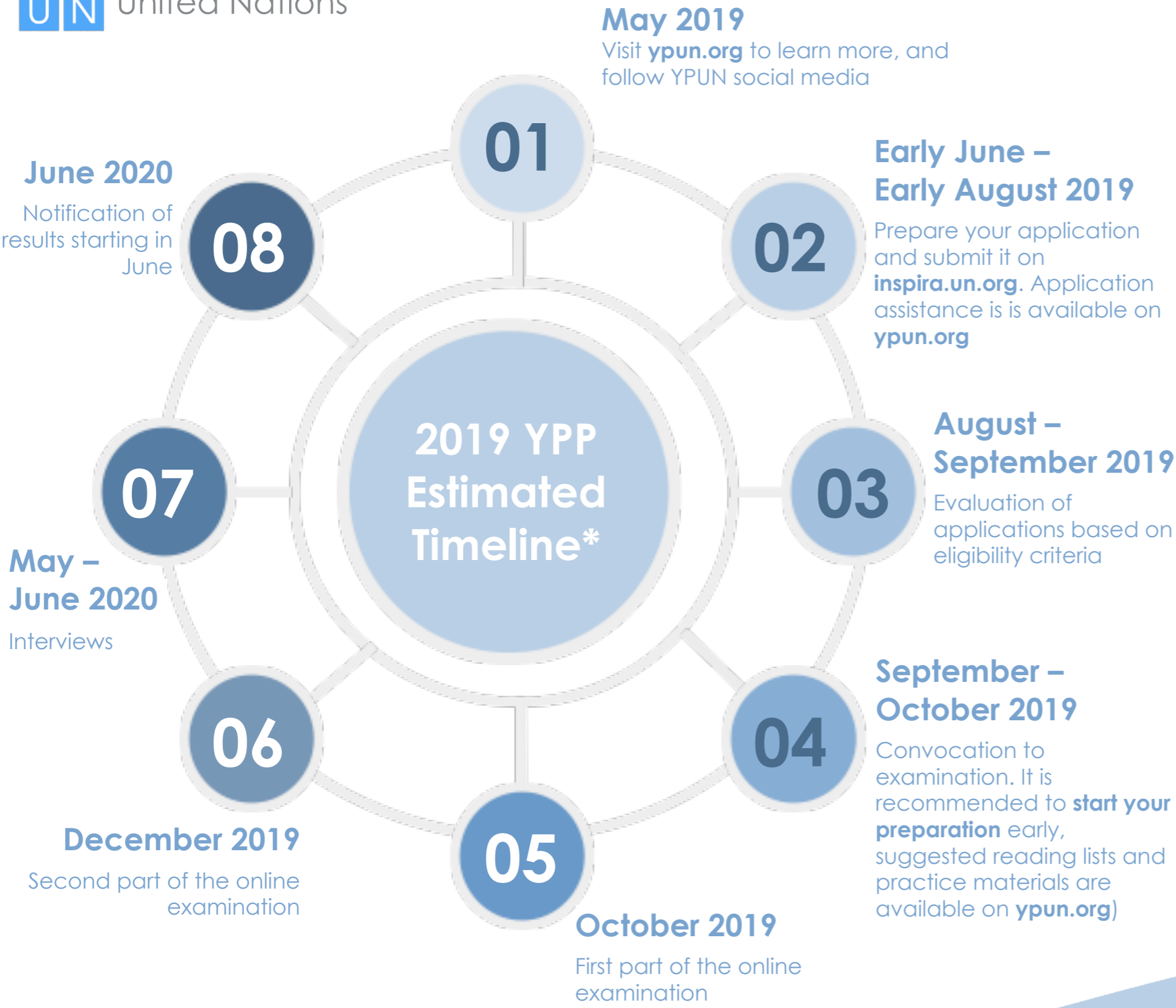
