Venue

During the dry season, which lasts from October to April, it is cold and there is very little rainfall, except from January to March, when the weather is still cold but there is some light rain. The wet season, from May to September, is hot with heavy rains and storms.

Many traditional handicrafts are also practiced in Hanoi including bronze molding, silver carving, lacquer, and embroidery. Hanoi has many famous traditional handicraft villages such as Bat Trang pottery village, Ngu Xa bronze casting village, Yen Thai glossy silk...



Vietnam

Vietnam has numerous of beautiful beaches and primeval forests where a wide range of precious and rare animals and plants can be found, as well as highlands with a temperate climate and spectacular landscapes.

Most Vietnamese ethnic groups are fond of poetry and literature. Art forms such as folk song, love duet song, ca tru (ceremonial song), classical drama, traditional operetta and puppetry are very popular.
